ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE: 15 August 2024

The APS is an opportunity to facilitate the exchange of knowledge, information, and field experience. The scientific committee will review your abstract for an oral or poster presentation to ensure it meets all requirements. Editorial revisions may be requested before a final determination of abstract acceptance can be made.

Overall Requirements

- **Maximum 250-word count**, excluding title, author info, and keywords.
- Include a title of 12 words maximum, the email address of the first author, and three keywords.
- Write the abstract as a single-block paragraph.
- Common or scientific names of species must appear in the title or the body.

Specific Requirements

- **Title and Affiliation** - The title should be concise. Clearly state the problem/question/program/findings, species, housing (zoo-living, lab-housed, sanctuary, field, etc.), and, if relevant, location.
- **Body (250-word limit)**
 - Introduction: Clearly state the research questions or problems, hypotheses, predictions, etc.
 - Methods: Include the basic design of the study, sample size, data collection techniques, and size of the data set.
 - Results: Include an explicit statement of results.
 - Conclusion: End with implications of the results, linking them to the purpose of the study. **Abstracts stating "results will be discussed" will be sent back for revisions.**
 - For descriptive presentations: **Introduction:** Clearly state the situation that you are describing (new behavior, new study site, new techniques, community education, conservation strategies, etc.). **Discussion:** Clearly describe the importance of the situation to primates, primatology, and/or the scientific community.

CRITERIA FOR ABSTRACT ACCEPTANCE

- Abstracts should summarize your work so that your presentation can be understood without any supporting or additional material.
- Abstracts should be clearly written.
- Submitting Authors will be notified of the status of their abstracts by 15 September 2024.
